# ORACLE CUSTOMER DATA MANAGEMENT MODEL












# ORACLE ORDER MANAGEMENT MODEL




# SIMPLIFIED PROMATIS DATA MODEL MDM








# SIMPLIFIED PROMATIS DATA MODEL 02C








# SIMPLIFIED PROMATIS DATA MODEL AR







# PROMATIS DATASMART FOR HYBRID SYSTEMS









## **AVAILABLE PLUGINS**

A tailor-made standard solution for every requirement

- MDM: Extraction of complete master data records (customers, suppliers, items,...)
- MEC: Provision of tax-relevant data for tax authorities (transmission to IDEA)
- P2P: Extraction of supplier-relevant transactional data (requisitions, purchase orders,...)
- O2C: Extraction of customer-specific transactional data (sales orders, shipments, customer invoices)
- VAT-Extractor: Electronic transmission of VAT information





# Questions and Follow up





## **SUMMARY DATASMART**

- Incremental data upload available: Only new or modified records will be transferred into the DataSmart → Reduced transmission time.
- Data from several sources can be uploaded.
- An Oracle database is required to use DataSmart.
- Possibility to visualize and evaluate data (e.g. using APEX, Tableau, Qlikview,...).
- Common data model can be adjusted based on clients' requirements.
